ATCL INSTRUMENTAL/VOCAL TEACHING

Equivalent in difficulty to the first year of an undergraduate degree and aimed at individual or small group teaching. You must be aged 18 or over and have passed grade 8 or above in the instrument you are teaching.

LTCL INSTRUMENTAL/VOCAL TEACHING

A step up from ATCL equivalent to completion of the final year of a full-time undergraduate course. Also aimed at teaching individual or small instrumental groups. You must be aged 21 or over and have passed grade 8 or above in the instrument you are teaching.

LTCL MUSIC TEACHING

A similar examination but aimed at teachers of larger classroom groups of at least 15 students. You must be aged 21 or over but the instrumental requirement drops to grade 6 on any instrument.
